DELHI - AGRA SIGHTSEEING TOUR 01 NIGHT / 02 DAYS

Day 01: Delhi /Agra (235 km / 05 h)

In the early morning our driver picks you up at your hotel and you proceed for an excursion trip to Agra. Almost everyone who hears the word "Agra" imagines splendid Taj Mahal. Built by Emperor Shah Jahan as a memorial for his second and the most lovable wife, Mumtaz Mahal, who died while giving birth to their 14th child, Taj Mahal is the most extravagant monument of love ever built. Inside the courtyard you can admire the ornamental gardens, a small museum that houses original architectural drawings of the Taj, white minarets, the red sandstone mosque and of course the central Taj structure made of semi translucent white marble, carved with flowers and inlaid with thousands of semiprecious stones in beautiful patterns.



On the way you visit Fatehpur Sikri, a fascinating ghost town, which lies a little beyond Agra. This deserted Red sandstone city was built by Emperor Akbar as his capital. Set like a jewel in a courtyard of pink sandstone is the marble tomb of the Saint Salim Chisti, enclosed by delicately carved marble screens. On arrival in Agra you check in at the hotel and after refreshment visit the Agra Fort. Built alongside the River Yamuna the magnificent Fort symbolizes the stature and power of the Mughal Emperor Akbar.

Overnight will be in hotel Jaypee Palace

Day 02: Agra / Delhi (204 km / 04 h)

In the early morning you visit "the epitome of love", the Taj Mahal at sunrise. The Taj Mahal, the white marble memorial, was built by Shah Jahan for his wife Mumtaz Mahal. The monument sums up many of the former themes that are found in the Islamic architecture. Its refined elegance is a visible contrast of both the Hindu architecture of pre-Islamic India, with its thick walls, corbelled arches, and heavy lintels, and the Indo-Islamic styles, in which Hindu elements are combined with an extensive assortment of motifs from Persian and Turkish sources.
